ORDER

1. The petitioner requested for issuing directions to Delhi Subordinate Services Selection Board to provide facility of scribe to disabled candidates in conformity with the office memorandum no.F.No./16-110/2003-DD.III dated 26.2.13 issued by Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment Government of India and it was further stated that there is no provision under the guidelines for checking the original Disability Certificate of the candidate and its authentication by the designated officer of the Delhi Subordinate Services Selection Board on the day of the examination.
2. A copy of the representation was sent to the Secretary Delhi Subordinate Services Selection Board for sending comments in the matter and since the reply received from the concerned officers of the Board were not satisfactory hearings were held in the matter.
3. During the course of the hearings it was stated by the representative of the Board that it was necessary to prescribe educational qualification, marks scored and other such restriction for the scribe as in case the scribe engaged for writing the examination is better qualified he or she would be in a position to secure better on the basis of his qualification

The authenticity of the original disability certificate on the date of the examination is being done only to simplify the procedure for such verification.

4. I have perused the representation and the replies received from the concerned officers of the Delhi Subordinate Services Selection Board and I am of the considered opinion that it is necessary that the instructions issued by the Government of India vide office memorandum F.No./16-110/2003-DD.III dated 26.2.13 are followed in letter and spirit and that the authentication of the disability certificate should also be done in such a manner as not to inconvenience the concerned disabled person. It is hoped that the Chairman of the Board would look into these issues and take appropriate decisions and issue necessary instructions in consonance with the guidelines issued by the Government of India.
5. Ordered accordingly.
