ORDER

- 1. Mr.Haider Hasan S/o Mr.Shamshul Hasan filed a petition stating that he secured 84.25 marks in the examination conducted by the Delhi Subordinate Services Selection Board for recruitment of Primary Teachers in the Municipal Corporation of Delhi. The petitioner also stated that he belongs to other backward class and while filling the form he mentioned that his application may be considered in the category of other backward class / hearing impaired. The petitioner stated that he had obtained 84.25 marks and that candidates securing 70 marks under the category of other backward classes were selected and he was not selected. The Delhi Subordinate Services Selection Board was directed to consider his application and take appropriate action.
- 2. The Controller of Examination informed that the post of Primary School Teacher in the Municipal Corporation of Delhi is not identified as suitable for Hearing Impaired category and therefore he was not recommended for appointment. Further the petitioner was well aware that he was not eligible for a post of Primary School Teacher he still applied for the post and now he is falsely claiming his right as a successful candidate.
- 3. I have perused the representation of the petitioner and also the reply received from the Controller of Examinations Delhi Subordinate Services Selection Board and I am of the
