## **ORDER**

J.L.N.Marg, New Delhi

- 1. A representation was filed by Ms.Zeenat Parveen D-129, Phase-I, Pappan Kalan Sector-3, Dwarka New Delhi-110078 stating that she is a disabled person and that a booth/kiosk may be allotted to her to enable her to earn her livelihood and also to look after her parents who are aged. She had applied on 10.2.14 but no response had been received so far from the office of the Deputy Commissioner Najafgarh South Delhi Municipal Corporation.
- 2. A copy of the petition was sent to the Commissioner South Delhi Municipal Corporation for filing comments. Since no comments were received a hearing was fixed. During the course of the hearing it was informed that as per the order dated 9.9.13 of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India Quote "All the existing street Vendors/Hawkers operating across the country shall be allowed to operate till the exercise of registration and creation of vending/hawking zones is completed in terms of the 2009 Policy. Once that exercise is completed they shall be entitled to operate only in accordance with the orders/directions of the concerned Town Vending Committee." Unquote and that Quote "The Town Vending Committee has been constituted at Headquarter level and its comprehensive/extant rules/guidelines have not been received in this office so far. In

view of the above circumstances all such cases for allotment of vending site/PCO Booth will be processed only after receiving of comprehensive/extant rules/guidelines in this regard from Town Vending Committee." **Unquote.** 

- 3. In view of the reply of the representative of the Commissioner South Delhi Municipal Corporation the case of the petitioner would be processed after the rules framed by the Town Vending Committee are approved by the Government and as per the directions of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.
- 4. The case is disposed off accordingly.
