ORDER

The above named complainant, a person with 73% hearing impairment vide his complaint dated 09.07.2015 submitted that he is Assistant Incharge in DTC since 06.02.1984. Dr. Baba Sehba Ambedkar Hospital issued him a disability certificate for 73% hearing impairment on 05.08.2014. He submitted an application dated 29.05.2015 for ground of transport allowance at double the normal rate. In accordance with the order dated 12.02.2013 Hon'ble Supreme Court writ petition civil No. 107/2011. He requested that his case may also be linked with the case of Sh. B.C.Pant, Sr. Stenographer in DTC which is under consideration.

2. The complaint was taken up with the respondent vide communication dated 16.07.2015. Thereafter a hearing was held in the matter. Vide his letter dated 30.06.2016, The complainant informed that DTC has granted him the benefit of transport allowance at double the

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normal rate and shall calculate the arrears w.e.f 24.07.2015, the date of issue of disability certificate. In view of this, complaint disposed off.
